Basic Keyboard Control

You can use the keyboard to move aircraft control surfaces, change engine power, operate aircraft systems, change views, and so forth. This topic lists key combinations for the basic flight and engine controls and aircraft systems. You can find information about other key combinations in the topics that follow.

NOTE: When you see a single key name, press that key. If you see two key names joined by a plus sign, press those keys simultaneously. If you see two or more keys separated by commas, press those keys in sequence.
