1. What are the advantages of using a text editor instead of a full-blown word processor?

3. What attribute controls the document's background color?
4. How are colors expressed as attribute values?
5. What does the BACKGROUND attribute do?

Exercise

Procedure:

1. In your student folder, create a new folder (by right clicking inside your folder, choose new folder) and name it exercises.
2. Next, use the START menu, choose programs, then accessories, then choose NOTEPAD. Type the following code into the NOTEPAD window:

```
<HTML>
<HEAD>
<TITLE>XYZ Corporation</TITLE>
</HEAD>
<BODY BGCOLOR="#FFFFFF">
</BODY>
</HTML>
```

3. When finished, save your document to the folder you just created. Make sure when you are saving it you name the file "index.htm" (use the quotes!)
4. Now, open My Computer, then open the new exercises folder from you data folder. Find the file, index.htm, you just made (it should have an explorer icon), double click it to view your web page.
