Objective: Create a new document using “save as”. Alter the document to change its text. Add a definition list.		

1. Open “resume.htm” in Internet Explorer (by double clicking on it.)
2. Using “Save As”, save your file in the exercises folder in the “L” drive as “resume2.htm”.
3. Change “Education” to “Employment”.
4. Change “Schools Attended” to “Jobs and Duties”
5. SELECT and CUT the entire Ordered and Un-Ordered lists you created.
6. Create a definition list <dl>.
7. Create a definition term <dt> and type the name of the employer.
8. Create a definition <dd> and describe your duties.
9. Make sure you close the <dt> and <dd>.
10. Do this again for all of your jobs (at least three if you make them up!).
11. Save your work
12. **SHOW YOUR KNOWLEDGE BONUS** – Indent the entire definition list with a blockquote. Make an ordered or unordered list as part of the definition. Make the font color or size of the definition term different.
