

Class: IT11 B HTML Lesson 7	Unit: HTML	Create a web page for a Mini Golf complex using your current knowledge of HTML
Objective: Create a web page from scratch. Name the file minigolf.htm and save it in your exercise folder.		

The Abbotsford Mini Golf Complex has asked you to create a simple web page for their establishment. The web page should demonstrate the ability to use lists (ordered, unordered, and definition), Special effects tags, and horizontal rules. The ability to use paragraphs and set-up a web page are accepted as already demonstrated. Go to the web and add a couple of images.

Use a definition list to list the employees of the Golf Complex:

Fox McCloud - The owner
Slippy Toad - The facility manager
Falco Lombardi - The pro shop salesman
Peppy Hare - Grounds Maintenance
Bunny Hop - Restaurant Manager

Use an ordered list to list each hole and the name of the hole(eg. The Windmill Strikes Back). You make up the names for the holes.

List the prices using an unordered list:

5.99 for adults
3.99 for students
2.99 for seniors
0.99 for kids under 1

Have at least one paragraph that will give a discussion of the history of the mini golf complex (eg. tournaments, famous people who have been there, services available, the importance of planning your stroke, etc.).

Have some fun with this assignment and make up some information, but follow the instructions in the first paragraph and demonstrate some of the techniques you have learned in the last two classes.
