Objective: Learn how to resize images and alter images for use on your web site. We will create a clickable thumbnail image on your resume page, and alter the image a bit to make it look better. We will use Adobe Image Styler, Adobe Photoshop or Microsoft Photo Editor

1. What do we mean by resize and image?
2. What is the difference between resizing and altering the height and width of an image in HTML?
3. What is a thumbnail?

Exercise

Procedure:

1. Open Image Styler
2. Choose file Place and place an image into window from your folder on the L drive. If there is a picture of you ... you should use that. It will be found in the P drive.
3. Resize the picture by using the control handles. Hold down the shift key so it will resize with the proper proportions.
4. Add any text if you like, then choose File ↗ Preview in Browser.
5. Right click on the picture and choose save. Save it as the same file name except put _sm in front of the file name.
6. Open your html resume.
7. Insert the small image you just made.
8. Create a hyperlink around this image so it links to your larger image.
9. Try to use Photoshop, or what ever program is demonstrated to alter your image.
10. Create a background using Image Styler or Photoshop.
11. Put this background in your resume.htm page.
